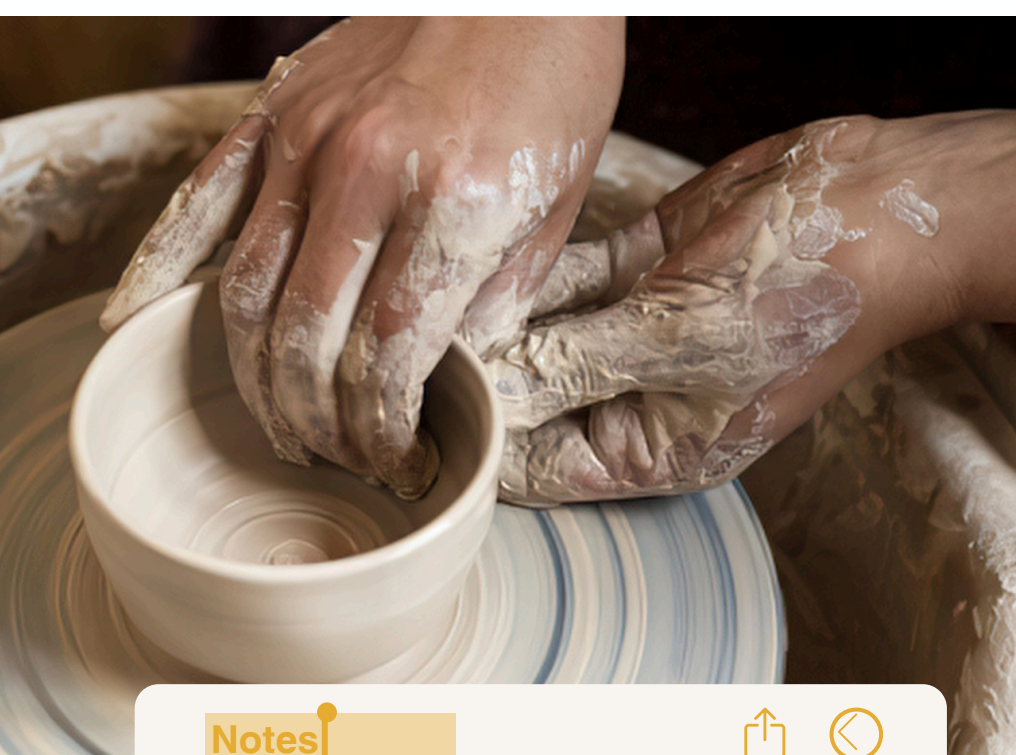
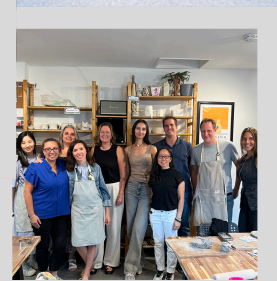

Hand Building *Packages*

Package 1: 2 Hour Workshop - 400 \$

Beginner friendly hand building workshop. Includes 10-15 minutes demo, 1 hour making and 20-30 minutes clean up.

Package 2: 2.5 Hour Workshop - 450 \$

Beginner friendly hand building and painting workshop. Includes 10-15 minutes demo, 1 hour making, 30 minutes painting and 20-30 minutes clean up.

Package 3: 3 Hour Workshop - 500 \$

Beginner friendly hand building and painting workshop. Includes 10-15 minutes demo, 1.5 hours making, 30 minutes painting and 20-30 minutes clean up.

* Prices are listed for up to 10 participants for a semi private event (hand building section and instructor will be reserved for your group but wheel throwing students or members might still be present in the studio working in their section. Group *Size*

We can accommodate up to 14 people for hand building events. For larger groups we host wheel and hand building combo where participants choose one of the activities (2 & 2.5 hour workshops) or switch stations in the middle to practice both methods (3 hour workshops)



Notes

- 2.5 hour - most optimal length for those who want to paint their pieces and explore hand building
- 3 hour - best for slow paced events and those that would like to have time set aside for cake/snacks and mingling
